Commitments with charter include:

- Ensuring that our contact centre offers all available methods to contact us, via the telephone, our website or various social media platforms
- Ensuring that there is a dedicated, named, neighbourhood policing team made up of police constables (PCs) and police community support officers (PCSOs) for your area, who will continue to work to understand local issues and provide consistency in your area
- Ensuring that the teams are led by a named sergeant and inspector, dedicated to their roles
- Ensuring that your SNTs' photographs and contact details, including mobile phone numbers, are accurate, up-to-date and easily accessible via our website and on social media platforms. This will enable you to contact the teams directly when they are on duty
- Promoting what we are doing in your local community, providing up-to-date information about policing in your neighbourhood on the West Mercia Police website, on social media, via traditional print and broadcast media and in your community via clear, easy to read posters


